

How to write a position paper?

Every delegate is expected to write a position paper before the conference. This is to make sure that every participant is thoroughly prepared for the debates. For your position paper please write about a paragraph on each of your committee's *Issues on the Agenda* and explain your country's position on them. The paper should be one to two pages long and sent to the chair of your committee by **August 31st, 2018**. You will soon find the list of chairs [here](#).

Also, there will be research reports on your topics on this website about two months ahead to the conference, which will give you a general overview on the issues.

First Issue to be debated

First of you should give a general overview of the issue. For example how it arose, which parties are involved etc...

Here you should mention measures that have already been taken by the world community, furthermore you're invited to show of what your country has done so far

The third paragraph should deal with what your country is planning to do to tackle the issue. You should propose your ideas and what you are willing to do here so that the chairs are prepared for your ideas and are prepared to in case help you in the debates.
